Eloy Fire District Permit and Compliance Guide

The Eloy Fire District adopts the 2018 International Codes (I-Codes) and references National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards.

Building Permit Application

To apply for a building permit, submit the following to the fire marshal:

- Eloy Fire permit application
- One-page site plan
- Complete set of plans (drawings)

If you're re-submitting approved plans, include the plan name or number. You can submit:

- One electronic set of plans, or
- Two paper sets.

For Commercial Projects:

Follow the same application process, but include documentation for required systems like sprinklers, standpipes, fire alarms, and kitchen suppression systems, even if deferred. Submit drawings and documentation, including calculations and component cut sheets.

After the review, the Eloy Fire District will invoice you for fees. The typical turnaround is 2 weeks for plan reviews and 2 working days for permits after payment. For questions, contact the fire marshal at 520-466-3544.

Fire & Life Safety System Reporting

Contractors must electronically submit all inspection and maintenance reports for fire & life safety systems within Arizona Fire & Medical Authority boundaries via <u>The Compliance Engine</u>.

- Automatic fire sprinkler systems
- Fire alarm systems
- Kitchen hood suppression systems
- Standpipes
- Smoke control systems
- Fire pumps
- Spray booths
- Emergency generators
- Special suppression systems
